Through the League, she is active with voter registration and regularly speaks to groups on election and voting issues.

Ms. Brown has a J.D. from Boston College Law School. She retired in 2015 as Executive Director of Housing Opportunities Made Equal, a local nonprofit addressing housing discrimination. She is past president of Affordable Housing Advocates, a Cincinnati area coalition, and received the Cincinnati Homeless Coalition's lifetime achievement award for her advocacy in fighting homelessness and poverty in Greater Cincinnati.
